

ANYTIME IS TRAIN TIME

The leading cause of vehicle-train collisions is driver error.

PROBLEM:

- an average freight train travelling at 100 km/hour can take up to 2 kms to stop
- a motorist is 40 times more likely to die in a collision with a train than a collision involving another vehicle
- approximately 50% of collisions at railway crossings occur where there are active railway signals
- 50% of teens admit to walking or playing on railway tracks
- 1 in 5 teens think they can get out of the way of the train on time
- Southwest Ontario has the highest number of level rail crossings

SOLUTION:

When approaching all railway crossings:

- approach with extreme caution
- obey rail signals
- look, listen, live

REMEMBER:

- Railway property is private property. Do not trespass.

Cross railway tracks as if your life depends on it, because it does!
