- Be 12 or 13 years of age by August 15, 2011
- Must reside in Chatham-Kent
- Must have an interest in policing

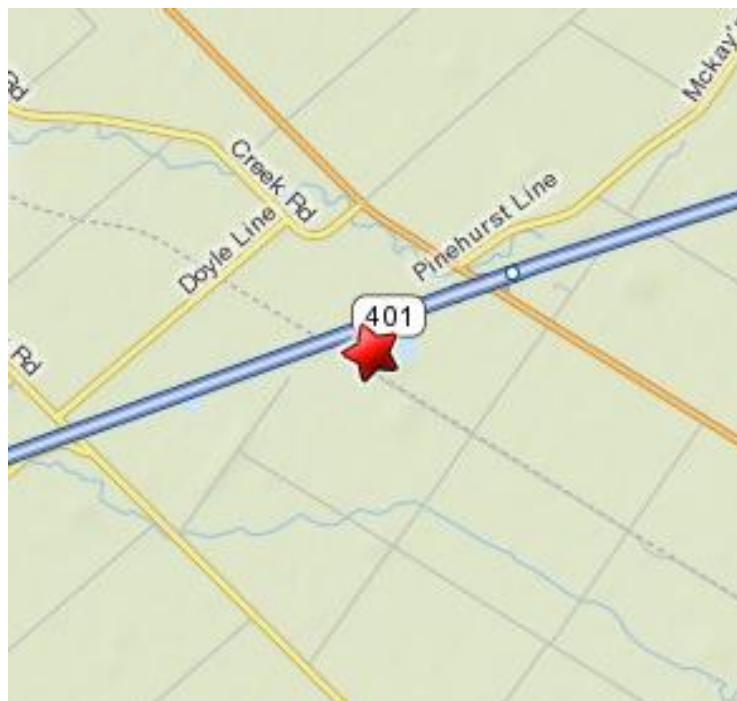
